All students are expected to come to school in clean and properly fitting uniforms with their hair styled neatly and with the proper hygiene. Daily personal grooming is very important. Pride in one's appearance is the first step in gaining self-esteem and confidence. Parents will be contacted if a student is out of uniform or comes to school poorly groomed.

The student dress code is an important part of the school program and philosophy. In making the choice to attend Case Preparatory Academy, the student with parent support agrees to follow all dress code requirements. The dress code is not an option for the student or parent. Not choosing to follow the dress code may lead to a change of learning modality.

The teacher and instructional aide are the prime enforcers of this policy. Occasionally, the building Administrator may have a building "dress down" day when students and staff may dress down (in reasonable fashion).

The student dress code is a follows:

Girls:

- Solid color polo collared shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Case Logo Shirts
- All shirts are to be tucked in at the waist.
- Navy blue, black, khaki skirts (knee length), jumpers, or pants. NO JEANS, NO COLORED JEANS, NO SWEAT PANTS, NO LEGGINGS, NO CARGO PANTS, NO OVERALLS, NO SHORTS.
- Black or brown belt must be worn with all pants
- Dark colored closed dress shoes, black or brown. NO TENNIS SHOES, NO DECK SHOES, NO MOCCASINS, SANDALS, NO SLIPPERS, NO FLIPFLOPS. Black or Brown boots may be worn during the months of December-April.
- Black, blue, white socks and or tights.

- Stud earrings only, safety reasons, no body jewelry, no facial jewelry. Watches are acceptable.
- No writing or pictures except the Case Preparatory Logo on any clothing- No seethrough clothing of any kind.

Boys:

- Solid color polo collared shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Case Logo Shirts
- All shirts are to be tucked in at the waist.
- Navy blue, black, khaki pants. NO JEANS, NO COLORED JEANS, NO SWEAT PANTS, NO CARGO PANTS, NO OVERALLS, NO SHORTS.
